Caddie academy opens at Petrifying Springs

The Caddie and Leadership Academy of Southeast Wisconsin, a new caddie program started by Phil Poletti, at Petrifying Springs GC in Kenosha, kicked off its inaugural season on June 13. The caddie program is a first for the course, which will encourage players to take a caddie by having the Academy pay for the entire base fee.

The program is designed to provide young men and women the opportunity to learn life lessons through exposure to the game of golf — and the value of a strong work ethic, social interaction and perseverance. In addition, the Academy will help the Wisconsin State Golf Association and Western Golf Association identify potential candidates for the Evans Caddie Scholarship program.

The academy has received financial support from the Wisconsin State Golf Association Foundation, the PGA of America, and the Western Golf Association.
